

2nd Sunday of Lent – The Transfiguration of Jesus

Gospel:

Six days later, Jesus took with him Peter and James and John, and led them up a high mountain apart, by themselves. And he was transfigured before them... Then a cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud there came a voice, 'This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him!' (Mark 9:2, 7)

What does Jesus' change mean to us? Jesus' change makes us realize we can change ourselves through prayer and our good actions/behaviour. Such like: spending more time with God or Jesus like sitting alone in a quiet place; more caring with others. Let us pray:
