

Fourth Sunday of Lent – 14th March 2021

Gospel:

Jesus said to a good Jewish leader, Nicodemus, 'Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life. For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. Indeed, God did not send the Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.' (John 3:14-17)

The Gospel of the Lord. Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

Who is the Son of Man? It is Jesus himself who would suffer and die in order to save us from our sins on Good Friday before he rose from the dead with a new life on Easter Sunday. Let us pray and reflect on what "new life" means for us:

Dear God,

You love us. We thank you. Why? You give us Jesus, he lives with us and within us.

Jesus is with us means you love us, you give us your life and faith.

This means you forgive our sins. God, give us your grace to accept your gift of Jesus into our hearts so we may have a new life. New life means forever.

Every day, we say "Yes" to Jesus. We walk with Jesus. We walk with God.
